

ANATOMY OF A DEEP CLEAN

Do you know what goes into a deep clean? Here is a breakdown of what makes up a professional deep clean. We recommend having your commercial space deep cleaned 2-4 times per year to ensure a sanitary, safe workplace.



CARPET CLEANING

Professional carpet cleaning begins with vacuuming to remove any dry soil and debris. Any major stains are spot cleaned using a special spot-cleaning machine that removes deep-set, difficult stains. Next, the entire carpet is pre-conditioned and then steam cleaned.

FLOOR CARE

Depending on the condition of your hard-surface flooring, deep cleaning for flooring may consist of a simple mop and spray buff, a top scrub and recoat, or a full strip of any old wax followed by the application of several coats of sealer and wax.



APPLIANCE CLEANING

Refrigerators, ovens, and other appliances often get left behind in regular cleanings, which is why it is important to get to them when doing a deep clean. Deep cleaning of appliances means removing all buildup and grime from the inside and outside and making sure to clean carefully in hard-to-reach areas that don't get cleaned when you do a quick wipe-down.



WALLS AND CEILINGS

Usually in day-to-day cleaning, people don't bother to clean walls and ceilings unless there is a noticeable mess. This means that dust, dirt, and grime slowly builds up on these areas. During a deep clean, professional cleaners will dust and clean all walls and ceilings, including light fixtures and ceiling fans.



WINDOWS, DRAPES, AND BLINDS

Deep cleaning includes getting your windows gleaming again, and not just the panes! Drapes and blinds often get missed, so during a deep cleaning window coverings should be dusted and cleaned thoroughly to remove any dust, dirt, and stains that may be lingering.



BATHROOMS

Even though bathrooms are spaces that are cleaned on a frequent basis, a deep clean is also important to thoroughly clean and disinfect the more difficult areas that do not always get as much attention as they need. These areas include tiles and grout, the inside of soap dispensers, light fixtures, and vents.
